Reporting to the Capital Planner, this position is a member of the TH Maintenance Team that is responsible for completing work orders provided by the Capital Planner and Maintenance Supervisor for the maintenance, repair and renovation of TH Rental Housing Units, and other TH Buildings including those in the community as well as structures at Moosehide Village, R-22 Land of Plenty, and the Cache Creek Camp. The incumbent utilizes a variety of trade skills to complete the required work, on time and within budget, and provides progress updates to the supervisor. This position is also occasionally tasked with working on special projects and for providing services at gatherings or events sponsored by different Departments or for the community at large. This position regularly works directly with the TH maintenance team on work orders and projects providing front-line support, coaching and technical / trade knowledge.
